11	Cream stonecrop	Sedum organense	Scalloped leaves, pale yellow, low-growing
12	Davis' knotweed	Koenigia davisae	Fleshy leaves, red stem, incusp flower, prostrate
13	Giant frasera/Monument plant	Frasera speciosa	Blooming!
14	Grand collomia	Collomia grandiflora	Sticky petals, peach color
15	Gray's catchfly	Silene grayi	striped narrow calyx, sticky stems catch bugs, tiny thin white petals

17	Great red/slender paintbrush	Castelleja miniata	Tall, large red flowr w/extending green bracts
